1. Why am I being invited to take part?

You are being invited to take part because your organisation is part of the Youth Specialist Homelessness Services sector in NSW. Youndations is leading a research and advocacy project to understand how static government funding is impacting providers like yours over the 2026-2031 funding cycle.

2. What is the purpose of this project?

The project will collect baseline data; track changes every 6 months and reflect on final outcomes by 2031. Your participation will help us build credible evidence for advocacy to improve future funding models and policy decisions.

3. What does participation involve?

Participation is voluntary, and you may stop at any time.

4. Will my information be kept confidential? Yes.

- You can choose to opt in to being named or contacted for further input.
- Only the Yfoundations Policy team will have access to identifiable data.

All data will be de-identified in public reporting unless you give permission otherwise.

5. Are there any risks?

This research involves minimal risk. You may feel frustrated reflecting on service gaps or pressures. You may skip questions if you do not wish to answer. If you need support, you can contact us for debriefing options.

6. Are there any benefits?

While there is no direct benefit to you, the collective data will support advocacy to improve future funding and working conditions across the sector. You will

This project is led by Yfoundations, the peak body for youth homelessness in NSW. The Yfoundations Commissioning Working Group acts as the steering committee for this project, overseeing data quality, reviewing findings and providing advice on reporting.

9. What happens after the project ends?

A final report with cumulative findings and recommendations will be released in 2031. Participants will receive a copy. Data will be securely stored until 2036, then deleted.
